

Dear Parents,

We are delighted that your child is attending Community Bible Chapel's "KIDS CLUB". We are planning on having lots of fun learning of God and how He does stuff.

Here is some General Information you will want to know.

1. KIDS CLUB is for children age 5 to 5th grade.
2. Club will be meeting every Wednesday night from October 4, 2017 to March 28, 2018.

If there is NO SCHOOL or school is dismissed early due to inclement weather, there will be NO CLUB that Wednesday evening. If inclement weather happens after school hours, please listen to WJNR for cancellations.

If your child is too sick to attend school on club day, then your child would not be attending club either. Please help us keep everyone healthy.

3. Time of Wednesday Club is 6:30 - 8:00 pm. Your child is welcome to come a little early. This way, attendance can be taken and their memory verse can be said to their leader before club "officially" starts.

4. Memory Verse and Take Home Sheets:

With this note is a sheet of the weekly memory verses your child will be learning. They will be memorizing one verse a week to tell to their leader. Listening to your child practice the memory verse during the week will be a big help to them! A list of the verses is on the website: cbchapel.com. as is all of this information. We will be sending home a "Quiet time sheet" as well as a "verse token". (The verse of the week on a small piece of paper.) This book / sheet is for your child to do during the week. Your child is expected to bring back the book / sheet each week. You may want to help them accomplish this.

4. Missionary Offering:

We will be learning about and supporting various missionaries throughout the year. Each week, your child will have the opportunity to give money to these missionaries. This is NOT a requirement. This is ONLY if you and your child want to give.
